DOOR COUNTY, DELLS AND HOUSE ON THE ROCK

DAY ONE: Leaving St. Louis, we'll travel north in our deluxe motorcoach through the green river bottoms and rolling fields of Illinois into beautiful Wisconsin. There will be stops along the way, including lunch, and we'll arrive for our overnight and dinner near Milwaukee, WI.

DAY TWO: After a short drive north, we will arrive in the village of Manitowoc, alona Lake Michiaan. here we will explore the Wisconsin Maritime Museum to explore the rich history of the Great Lakes region from the sailors, shipbuilders and submariners who made that history including the nation's most completely restored WWII submarine, the USS COBIA. After lunch, we arrive in Sturgeon Bay, the gateway to Door County, known for its rich maritime heritage, vibrant arts scene, and stunning natural landscapes. We will visit the Door County Historical Museum prior to checking into our accommodations for the next two nights. This evening we will partake in the authentic traditional Fish Boil, an integral part of Door County Scandinavian culture and have been one of the area's most alluring attractions for more than 70 years!

DAY THREE: Our day begins with exploring the Door County peninsula from the coastline to the villages. This morning we board the popular Door County Trolley for touring the Peninsula State Park (Fall foliage should be great) with breathtaking views of green bay and stop at the Eagle Bluff Lighthouse. A stop at the Lautenbach's Orchard Country Winery and Market where fresh Door

County Cherry strudel and turnovers will be in season along with their signature ciders. For lunch and browsing, we will visit the quaint villages of **Fish Creek** and **Egg Harbor**. A wonderful day exploring Door County!

DAY FOUR: Departing the peninsula, Wisconsin country roads lead us to historic, popular and iconic Wisconsin Dells. Named for the stunning and unique sandstone formations alona the winding **Wisconsin River**, the Dells began as a sleepy tourist destination in the 1950's. Drawing more and more crowds through the years with waterskiing shows, boat tours, carnivals and local oddity shops, the Wisconsin Dells is a "must see" destination! Our first stop is for our narrated Upper Dells Boat Cruise along the Wisconsin River. This journey along glacial cut channels allows for views of the sandstone towers, birch and pine crowned cliffs, and alimpses of Wisconsin wildlife. There are two shore stops where you can wander into the narrow stone passages along the river to see "Witches Gulch" and "Stand Rock" featuring the famous dog jump. Afterwards, enjoy some leisure time to duck into the many shops along the historic main drive. We will also stop at Parson's trading Post - The Dells original Native American shop and museum. Our overnight for the next two evenings will be in the Dells/Baraboo area.

DAY FIVE: After breakfast, we'll board the coach for a short drive to the famous **House on the Rock** in Spring Green, WI. Built in 1960 by Alex Jordan, his dream home atop a rocky outcrop expanded into a labyrinth of collections of oddities

much more. This is truly an experience that is "hard to describe" in all ways including the famous Infinity Room, Streets of Yesterday and fabulous carousel showcasing a dazzling 269 animals, 20,000 lights and 182 chandeliers! This evening, enjoy a true Wisconsin Supper Club Fish Fry (or broiled) – fresh caught Cod, Blue Gill and Perch (or meat) served with all the trimmings.

DAY SIX: We'll board our motorcoach for a comfortable scenic ride back to St. Louis, arriving by early evening.

DAY ONE: New Mexico offers a unique and vibrant travel experience, rich in culture, history, and Southwest natural beauty. This morning after our flights to Albuquerque, NM, we will enjoy lunch along Albuquerque's historic Route 66 district. Then we will board the Railrunner Train for our hour and a half scenic trip north into Santa Fe, NM. One of the nation's well-known artist communities, Santa Fe, offers a unique blend of Native American, Spanish, Mexican, and Anglo cultures, all set against a backdrop of stunning desert landscapes and adobe architecture. We will check into our comfortable Santa Fe accommodations for the next four nights. This evening we will enjoy a welcome dinner together.

DAY TWO: Enjoy breakfast each morning at the hotel. We will spend our day exploring Sante Fe by the Loretto Line open-air tram tour. Our local guide provides in-depth information city's archaeology, the architecture, local art/galleries, and the history of Santa Fe and the region. Our eight mile loop will take us to the most important historical areas in Santa Fe, including Canyon Road and its colorful art galleries, Santa Fe's Museum Hill area, the historic Santa Fe Plaza and the **Palace of the Governors**, and other notable locations in the heart of the oldest capital city in the United States. After lunch and browsing in the culturally rich and historic downtown area, we will visit Santa Fe's architectural gem best known for its miraculous spiral staircase - The Loretto Chapel. Dinner will be at a local favorite prior to returning to hotel.

DAY THREE: This morning after breakfast we travel north to Chama, NM where we will board the magnificent Chama Limited. This is a scenic train excursion on the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad. Hands down, this excursion is one of Cornerstone's Board Members' favorite Autumn Southwest rail journeys. We will board the heritage narrow-gauge historic train cars for a round-trip journey covering 32-miles (just over 6 hours) traveling from Chama to Osier Station and back, providing breathtaking views of the Southern Rocky Mountains. This time of year (if nature provides) the Aspen trees, known for their striking white bark and heart-shaped leaves shimmer in brilliant yellow color. Hot lunch at scenic Osier Station included before our afternoon trip back to Chama. We will break for dinner enroute back to Santa Fe and our hotel.

DAY FOUR: We depart our hotel to the Southwest's largest art district -Canyon Road. More than a hundred galleries, boutiques and restaurants in one half mile - you will be able to see fine art and jewelry from artists throughout the United States and the world, all in one place. If you're not a shopper - don't worry, this street is beautiful to stroll - with historic adobe style architechture, colorful creations, and great people watching to boot! On Museum Hill we will visit the Museum of Indian Arts & Culture telling the stories of the people of the Southwest from pre-history through contemporary times. The museum's enormous collection includes over 80,000 archaeological, ethnographic,

and more than 10 million artifacts from almost 12,000 carefully excavated archaeological sites across New Mexico. This evening after dinner, we will enjoy a Native American storyteller presentation at our hotel.

DAY FIVE: After breakfast and checking out of our hotel, we will have time to visit the famous Georgia O'Keeffe Museum dedicated to preserving and showcasing the life and work of the iconic American modernist painter, Georgia O'Keeffe. Inside there are over 3,000 works, including 140 oil paintings, nearly 700 drawings, and numerous other pieces spanning from 1901 to 1984. After a lunch break we will arrive back at the Albuquerque Airport for our flights back to St. Louis.

We will make several stops along the way including a stop for an a tropical drink at Robbie's of Islamorada! Robbie's is a staple in the upper keys and home of the world-famous tarpon feedings and a great place to kickback and let the fresh sea air and swaying palms relax your mind, body and soul. Later this afternoon we will arrive in Marathon perfectly centered in the mid-Keys for our exploring ghead. We will check into our four-star accommodations for the next three nights at Faro Blanco Resort & Yacht Club, by Hilton. Our accommodations include a salt water pool, and walking paths along the harbor all in a tranquil Keys setting. This evening enjoy an included delicious welcome dinner with your traveling friends.

We will have time for an early dinner before our relaxing evening aboard the Marathon Mermaid while enjoying champagne, music, good times, and incredible sunset views. One of the best ways to experience the Keys!

DAY THREE: We depart our hotel to the largest and most colorful town of the Keys - Key West! A full day to experience this unique town together and on your own. 





Discovering Shared Humanity





SEDONA, GRAND CANYON AND VERDE CANYON RAILROAD




